Dan's complex litigation cases, includes routinely handling multi-million-dollar disputes, and, if necessary, he has successfully defended cases from inception through trial and appeal, including obtaining reported decisions on additional insured endorsements and triggers for defense obligations.

Dan also serves his clients by providing insurance coverage recommendations and litigating same, including analyzing policies of insurance purportedly providing primary and/or excess coverage related to commercial general liability, professional liability, property liability, and trucking liability. He began his career as an associate at a law firm handling insurance coverage, construction defect, and products liability matters, and served as lead associate on appeals to the Appellate Division and assisted on briefs to the New York State Court of Appeals.
