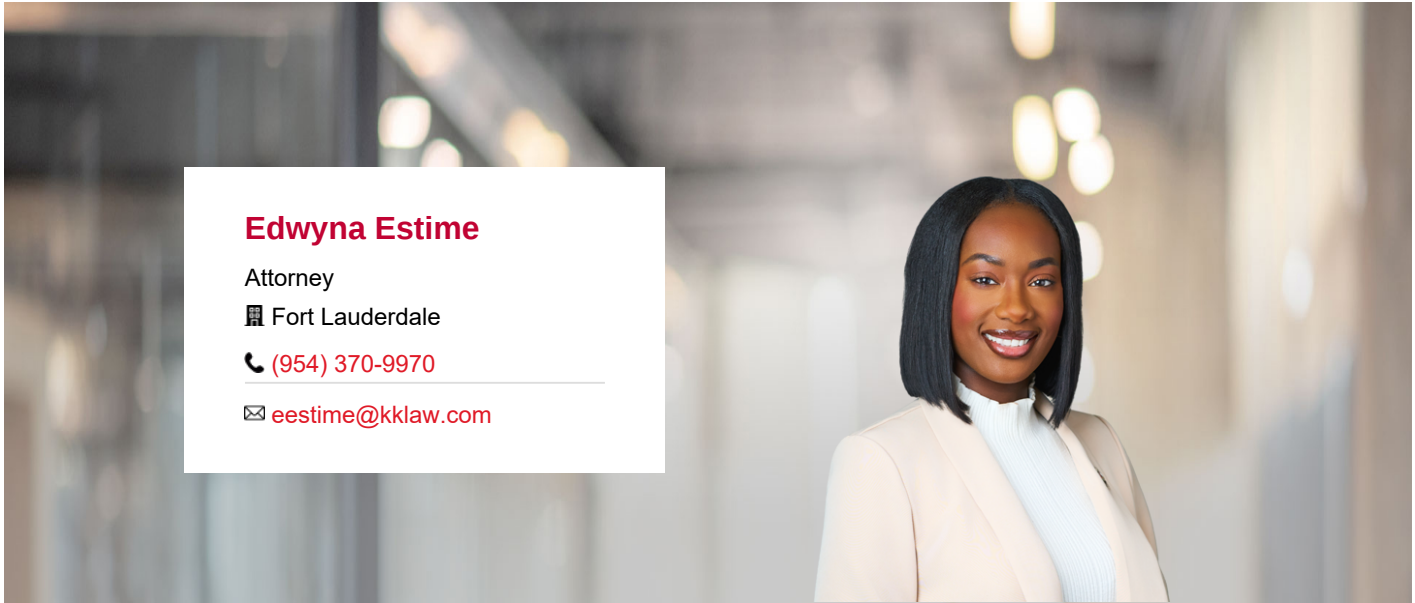

Biography
